Award: Multiple winners/Amount Varies Deadline: April 1
- HELEN R. AHL SCHOLARSHIP**
Graduating seniors of Carlisle High School, who are planning to attend a 2 year or 4 year college or trade/technical school of higher education.
Award: Multiple winners/Amount varies Deadline: Springtime
- AMES TRUE TEMPER CHARITABLE FOUNDATION**
Graduating seniors with a minimum 3.0 GPA, who are dependent children of associates of Ames True Temper Inc., and plan to attend a post-secondary educational institution.
Award: Varies/up to \$4,000 per year for up to 4 years Deadline: April 15
- ROBBIE BARRON MEMORIAL FUND**
Graduating seniors from Cedar Cliff High School, who also attended Hillside Elementary.
Award: 1 winner/Amount varies Deadline: April 1
- BEISTLE COMPANY SCHOLARSHIP**
Students who are legal dependents of full-time employees of the Beistle Company; second preference may be given to students graduating from Shippensburg High School; third preference may be given to students graduating from high schools within a 30 mile radius of Shippensburg.
Award: Varies/Up to \$1,000 per year for up to 4 years Deadline: April 1
