If students or staff have any of the following symptoms below, they MUST		
stay home and contact a health care provider for further instructions.		
1. Have a temperature of 100.4 or greater	Yes	No

3. Have any of the symptoms pictured below.	Yes	No



Remember, if ANY of the answers are YES, the student or staff member MUST stay home.

Students and staff members may not return until ALL of the following have been met:

- A health care provider has advised that they DO NOT need to obtain a COVID-19 test or isolate due to symptoms
 AND
- They have been symptom free for at least 24 hours without the use of medication.

(please see back for what to do if a student or staff member has COVID-19 or is exposed to someone with COVID-19)

Testing Positive or Having an Exposure

Students and staff members must also stay home in the following situations:

- 1. Student or staff member has received a positive COVID-19 test or has been told to isolate due to symptoms;
- 2. Student or staff member has been exposed to someone who has COVID-19;
- 3. Student or staff member has traveled outside of the state and it is recommended or ordered that they quarantine for 14 days upon return.

Parents/guardians should complete and submit the *Student Reporting Form* located on the district website and await further instructions from a health care provider, public health worker, or school district staff member prior to returning to school. Upon receipt of the *Student Reporting Form*, a member of the District Pandemic Response Team will contact parents/guardians for further instructions.

Staff members should complete and submit the *Staff Self-Reporting Form* located on the district website and await further instructions from a health care provider, public health worker, or school district staff member prior to returning to school. Upon receipt of the *Staff Self-Reporting Form*, a member of the District Pandemic Response team will contact staff members with further instructions.
